

LOCAL DAY 2016

Sponsored by the Nebraska Hunter Jumper Schooling Show Circuit

Local Day is an event designed to give aspiring youth and amateur riders the opportunity to experience competition free-of-charge at a world class horse show and venue of the 2017 FEI World Cup! Eligible riders include any junior or amateur not competing at the International Omaha Horse Show that have qualified to participate by selling vouchers to the 2016 event. 20-25 participants will be picked to ride (depending on schedule) and compete free-of-charge at this top rated show and facility with expert course designers, judges and officials.

New this year:

Vouchers are \$15 (\$15 off the box office price) and are redeemable for tickets in the Lower Bowl for one night of competition.

Local Day Rules:

1. Local Day is open to junior and amateur riders (according to USEF rules). No professionals please! Anyone competing in regularly scheduled classes at the International are not eligible for this class.
2. One class will be offered at 0.85 meters (Table II.2.1). Only 20-25 riders will be invited to compete. The class is open to both horses and ponies.
3. All horses identified for the class must have a current negative Coggins (within twelve months of the show) and a current health certificate identifying all vaccinations and current state of health. This information must be presented to management during the mandatory riders' meeting.
4. The Local Day class will be offered at no charge for individuals who participate in the selling of vouchers for the International Omaha Horse Show 2016. Sale forms can be printed off from the Local Day page of the International's website (www.InternationalOmaha.com) or by contacting Sybil Greene at local_day_internationalomaha@aol.com
5. In the event that there are more eligible riders than the class can accommodate, the number of vouchers sold will determine participating and reserve riders.
6. All Local Day sales forms must either be mailed to 3026 S. 2 Street, Lincoln, NE 68502 or turned in at designated locations (locations will be posted on the NHJSSC Facebook page). You must have the form completed with payment to receive vouchers. No vouchers will be distributed without payment. **NO EXCEPTIONS! Please mail checks and forms to Sybil at 3026 S. 27th Street, Lincoln NE 68502. Forms due no later than April 8, 2016.**
7. The official list of riders for the Local Day class will be posted on April 11, 2016. Participants will be notified per the information provided on the sales form. Please make sure your sale form has your complete information. The International staff and the NHJSSC will not be responsible for incomplete

entries.

8. Those selected to compete will be required to fill out an entry form located on the International website (www.InternationalOmaha.com). Entry forms must be postmarked by April 20, 2016. **No late entries will be accepted.**
9. An order of go will be posted on the International website Local Day page and also on the NHJSSC Facebook page and website (<http://nebraskahorseshows.com>). Once the list is published, no substitutions or replacements will be allowed. The International and NHJSSC will make every attempt to update the list with any appropriate changes in order.
10. All individuals participating in the Local Day class must attend a mandatory meeting to be held Wednesday, May 4, 2016 at 6:00 pm. All riders and trainers must be present for the meeting in order to be eligible to compete. Parents are also encouraged to attend the meeting.
11. No stalls will be available to Local Day horses or riders. All participants must work off their trailer. A designated area will be identified for trailer parking.
12. Schooling time **TBA** on Thursday, May 5, with the class beginning promptly at 8:30 am. Please plan accordingly so that the class can run on schedule.
13. Proper show attire is requested. For safety, all riders must wear a boot with a heel and an ASTM approved helmet. Proper attire for Local Day is identified as a show shirt, show jacket, tan breeches, a boot with a heel, and an approved helmet. Proper tack will be enforced per current USEF rules.
14. A warm up area will be provided for all participants. Ten horses/riders will be allowed to enter the warm up ring at a time. Please identify where you are located in the order of go and plan accordingly.
15. Show management will monitor the schooling area and allow two riders on the ramp at a time. Only ten riders will be allowed in the schooling area at one time. Additional riders will be allowed to enter the schooling area at management's discretion.
16. Riders are encouraged to bring someone who can assist them with their horses during their time at Local Day. If stalls become available, they will be on a first-come-first-served basis.
17. Any person entering the CenturyLink Omaha grounds agrees to abide by the rules and regulation as set forth and further to abide by any decision, ruling or regulation issued by the competition as a condition of entry. Rules and regulations will run in accordance to the current rules of THE USEF of which body it is a regular member. The CenturyLink Omaha, The International Omaha staff, and the NHJSSC will not tolerate poor sportsmanship. Management has the right to refuse service to anyone they deem displaying poor sportsmanship.
18. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 8th place. There will be no victory gallop. If time allows, a mounted ceremony to receive ribbons will be done in the arena. Photographers will be on site and photos can be bought through them. No individuals other than those designated by the International Omaha will be allowed in the arena for photos or at any other time. Exhibitors are asked to walk back into the arena to receive their ribbons and prizes.
19. Horses will not be allowed to stay on trailers in parking lot after the class. Participants and horses are asked to leave property after the end of the class and awards ceremony. Please see International website www.InternationalOmaha.com for a listing of local barn accommodations.
